COOKIE POLICY

This cookie policy is established by DIXINO (hereinafter "DIXINO") publisher of the DIXINO site (hereinafter the "site"), whose headquarters is at rue de la procession 105 box 3; 1070 Brussels, Belgium, and whose company number is 0800193778, and email address contact@dixino.be (acting as data controller and hereinafter referred to as "we", "our" and "our").

We strive to offer you the best possible service and therefore wish to maintain your trust by informing you of our policy on the use and storage of cookies.

I. What is a cookie?

A cookie is a small text file placed on the hard drive of your computer or mobile device, issued by the server of the website you are visiting.

The cookie contains a unique code that allows its sender to recognize the device concerned (your computer or mobile device) each time the website is visited.

The cookie identifies your device's browser but never you personally. In addition, a website's server can only read cookies that it has placed itself and does not have access to other information on your computer or mobile device.

Cookies may be placed by the server of the website you are visiting ("first-party cookies") or by partners with whom this website collaborates ("third-party cookies").

II. Validity period of a cookie

Some cookies expire when you close your browser "session cookies", while others remain on your device for longer periods of time, sometimes until you manually delete them ("persistent cookies").

Generally speaking, cookies have a limited validity period. The most common period of validity is 30 days and the maximum period is 13 months from the day the cookie is placed on your terminal.

III. General purposes of cookies

The primary goal is to ensure more efficient and faster navigation (for example, a cookie remembers the language you choose, identifies you when you access your account, etc.). Cookies remember your preferences and thus speed up and facilitate your access to the site.

They also allow us to understand how you browse our site.

In addition, they offer the possibility of making the content of a website or the advertising on this site more relevant to you. The site will therefore be adapted to your personal tastes and needs.

IV. <u>Cookie management</u>

Most browsers use cookies. You can also delete these cookies or refuse their installation at any time and free of charge by modifying the options of your browser software. IN. Type the cookies

a) Cookies techniques

These cookies, which only contain your IP address, are essential to visit the site.

These cookies do not require your consent because they allow you to access the website.

b) Functional cookies

Thanks to them, we can:

- Personalize the services (language, currency, location, navigation data, etc.);
- Remember your choices during a previous visit;
- Collect information from online forms:
- Produce statistics;
- Analyze site usage.

Like technical cookies, these cookies are used to improve your browsing and do not require your consent.

c) Advertising cookies

These cookies give us information about your browsing habits and allow us to adapt the advertising content of our website to your interests.

Based on these, we can analyze the effectiveness of advertising campaigns, in particular by identifying the subsequent actions you take when clicking on these advertising banners. Additionally, based on geolocation data, we may tailor advertisements to you to make you aware of opportunities available near where you are located.

The information we collect and share only identifies your device.

For these cookies your consent is required and we ask for it when you access our website.

d) Analytical cookies

These cookies are used to collect information about how you visit our website. They allow us to measure the audience for the different contents and sections of our website in order to improve them.

Thanks to these cookies, we can detect navigation problems and improve the ergonomics of our website.

This data is collected and is therefore completely anonymous.

For these cookies we need your consent.
